The JRSOs would like all the children to participate in Road Safety Week 19th - 25th November 2018. We will be joined by Martin Andrews Road Safety Officer during this week.

During this week we would like to challenge everyone in our school to walk to school every morning so we can have a car free zone in Strickmere. There are lots of benefits to walking to school, it keeps us healthy and it helps to protect the environment. We will run a 'Walking Bus' each morning. The meeting points will be the Institute Car Park (Mrs Edwards and Mrs Marshall) and the top of Strickmere near Access (Mrs Bilner and Mr Bassett). If your child is joining a walking bus they will need to be at one of these points by 8.25am to begin walking at 8.30am.
