Music Skills

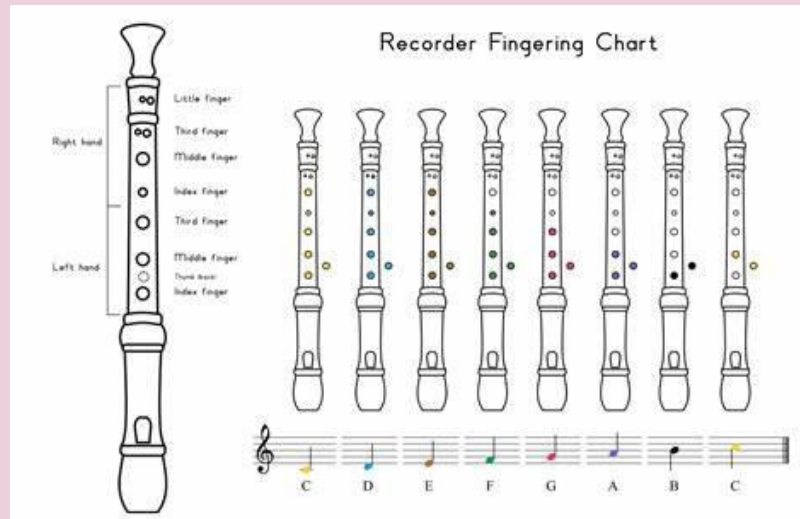
Pupils will:
