## Key Vocabulary:

**Dentist**: helps people to keep their teeth, gums and mouth healthy.

**Doctor:** people who are trained to give out medicines and care to people who are ill.

**Emergency**: When someone or something is in danger!

**Emergency Services**: They ensure that the public stay healthy and safe in our community.

**Firefighter**: is someone whose job is to put out fires and rescue people.

Healthy: feeling well and happy.

**Nurse**: are people who are trained to give out medicines and care to people who are ill. : is someone who works in an ambulance. They help people who have been injured or become ill very suddenly.

**Police officer:** works in a police station. They arrest criminals and prevent crime. They make sure people follow the rules to keep themselves and others safe.

Police Community Support Officer (PCSO): help members of the local community. They do not have the power of arrest.

**Rescue**: to free from danger **Safe**: protected from danger.
