Learning Objectives

To develop throwing, catching and running with the ball.

To develop an understanding of how to defend using tagging rules

To begin to use the 'forward pass' and 'offside' rule.

To develop movement skills to dodge a defender.

To track an opponent and begin to defend as a team.

To apply the rules and skills you have learnt and play in a tag rugby tournament.

Vocabulary

Co-ordination: moving two or more body parts at the same time

Control: being able to perform a skill with good technique

Momentum: the direction created by weight and power

React: to respond to quickly

Speed: how fast you are traveling

Technique: the action used correctly

Attacker: The team/player with the ball

Defender: The team/player trying to prevent the attacking team scoring.

Tag: The action of taking a tag from a player.

Forward Pass: The illegal action of passing the ball forwards.

Possession: The team with the ball.

Tag rugby is an invasion game. In this unit pupils develop their understanding of the attacking and defending principles of invasion games. In all games activities, pupils have to think about how they use skills, strategies and tactics to outwit the opposition. In tag rugby pupils do this by maintaining possession and moving the ball towards the try line to score.

Links to the National Curriculum

Pupils should continue to apply and develop a broader range of skills, learning how to use them in different ways and to link them to make actions and sequences of movement.

They should enjoy communicating, collaborating and competing with each other

They should develop an understanding of how to improve in different physical activities and sports and learn how to evaluate and recognise their own success.

Pupils should be taught to use running, jumping, throwing and catching in isolation and in combination.

Pupils should be taught to play competitive games, modified where appropriate and apply basic principles suitable for attacking and defending.
